

## PUBLIC NOTICE

Hydrant Training: April 22<sup>nd</sup> – May 20<sup>th</sup>

The fire department and Midstate Technical College will be performing hydrant training on fire hydrants in the Village of Biron. This will occur every Monday starting April 22<sup>nd</sup> and end on May 20<sup>th</sup>. They will be training between 6:00 p.m. and 9:30 p.m.

While training is occurring, you may notice a drop in pressure or see discoloration in your water. If discoloration occurs, let your water run for a few minutes, preferably from your outside hose connection, and it should clear up. The water is safe to drink even if it is discolored. If you are concerned with discoloration, you may not want to do laundry on the day hydrants are used. If your water pressure remains lower than normal after training has occurred, please clean your faucet screen to remove silt and mineral sediment that could be obstructing water flow.
